Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to accept the November meeting minutes as written.

Reports:

PCTVFD

- Hayride profits were \$ 24,000.

CII (Code Inspections Inc) –no report

Planning Commission – no report

Recreation Commission – had 16 children for ornament night – Breakfast with Santa is Saturday December 8th from 9-11 AM. They presented each Supervisor, Secretary and Treasurer a gift of a hand-painted ornament from the children.

Recreation requested an additional \$300.00 to pay for Santa’s Breakfast. – Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval for the Treasurer to transfer an additional amount into the Recreation account.

Roadmaster- The mower is ordered and will be delivered end of April or early May. Wing plow is on the truck.

Emergency Management Officer – Tom stated he contacted Geo Decisions and received a quote of \$3500.00 plus a yearly start fee of \$500.00 which will be a credit and depleted as used. The Township will pay GEO Decisions \$250.00 yearly.

Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to purchase the updated Reverse 911 plan.

Sewage Officer- no report

Zoning Officer- Daryl reported he has received requests for permits which are pending.

Continuing Business:

- Property Maintenance Ordinance update on 9000 Rt 87 Highway - Solicitor is working with Delinquent Tax Office
- Act 172 of 2016-firefighters getting a tax credit based on service, training, fundraising and update- on hold waiting for merits to be decided.
- Reverse 911 System renewal – discussed under EMA
- Adopt 2018 budget

Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to adopt the 2018 Budget as advertised.

- Verizon versus Zito for Township/EMA - After discussion it was decided by the Supervisors to install Zito at the Township building for phone and internet – this gives the Township internet service + phone service at the same price now being paid just for phone service which is spotty at times. The Township currently piggybacks wireless from the Barbour's Library. If works out then decisions will be made for Fire Company and EMA.

New Business:

- Category 4 casinos (mini-casinos) to operate within the township -letters from PSATS and Family Council were introduced as well as a Resolution to ban casinos. This was tabled for the December 27th meeting.
- PennDOT letter concerning resurfacing of Rt 87- Supervisor John Blair suggested PennDOT be informed the bank needs stabilized at Little Bear Creek up to top of hill before Loyalsock Manor Road.
- Intuit payroll upgrade for 2018 – Treasurer Carrie Stine received invoice the QuickBooks payroll for 2018 needed to be updated at a fee of \$650.00– Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval for Treasurer to pay the yearly fee.
