Barbours Cemetery Road:

Road is in good shape- could be graded up a bit.

Turkey Farm Road:

Entire road to be tar/chipped this year

Scaife Road:

Pot holes need fixed out past the black top. Needs pipe replaced (old plastic) should also haul out the millings to put on road.

Cabbage Hollow Road:

The first pipe needs replaced need to put the rock up the ditch (riprap) and haul more gravel. Needs stone (2B gravel)

Send letter to Fred Peet to clean up the scrape piles in his back yard.

Hickory Lane:

This road is to be tar/chip this year– about ¼ mile.

Lower Manor Road/Upper Manor- Loyalsock Manor:

Roads are in good shape – but potholes need fixed -Neil Bixler's driveway is higher than the road –needs a pipe – need to check to see if that is township maintenance or resident.

Dunwoody Road:

Lower and upper ends of road as well as section next to bridge (Dunwoody Club) to be tar and chip about 2-2/10 miles –Pot holes need fixed- looks like logging is being done on about 1 mile of the existing tar/chipped road – no permits were issued – Brad to check.
