Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to accept the March meeting minutes as written.

Reports:

PCTVFD – The Fire Company has signed the contract to locate cell tower on the fire company property which will generate \$1000.00 per month for the fire company plus 15% when other entities are signed on to the ATT tower.

- Designation of agent – FEMA buyout - agent needed for the township to proceed with the Nancy Wentzler 6655 Rt 87 Highway
- Secretary Patricia Johnson was appointed agent for Plunketts Creek Township with FEMA – Supervisor John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to appoint Secretary Patricia Johnson as agent.
- Further discussion was made concerning the other residents since Nancy Wentzler took the buy-out and where the residents stand as far as getting needed assistance to reinforce creek banks etc. along their properties. Secretary Patricia Johnson will push FEMA on this concern and see what if any plan exists.
- Mortgage foreclosure on Shelly Jo & Christopher Schaffer – 58 Chester Rd.
 - DEP – Water Obstruction & Encroachment Permit – King Run -Permit E41-689- check to see what this is for and who it is issued too.
 - Bigger Sewage Module – since nothing was received from county on the sub-division and the Sewage module was approved by Planning Commission and SEO – John Blair made a motion with unanimous approval to approve the Sewage module portion of the subdivision.
