Scaife Road:

Cold patch entrance, fix pot holes and sweep

Cabbage Hollow Road:

Good Condition – put stop sign back up and pick up the old road pipes to put in dumpsters on clean up day. Clean ditches, grade and sweep.

Hickory Lane:

Good Condition needs road sign put back up

Lower Manor Road/Upper Manor- Loyalsock Manor:

Roads are in good condition – Lower Manor needs the road sign put back up – check culvert pipe at Rich Raymond's. Roads need swept.

Dunwoody Road:

Cold patch edge of Danny's driveway – still 2 30" pipes needing replacement and an 18". Need to address repairs on the bridge by Dunwoody club -minor repairs the township can fix per Larson Design recommendations.
