REPORTS: PCTVFD: The PA Forestry Department gave a truck to the PCTVFD which will be used as a brush truck. It needs work but most parts and supplies have already been donated. It was reported to Brad since the last meeting that Jeremy Welshans would be covered by Workers Comp if he joined Task Force 80.

Emergency Management: No Report

Roadmaster: The West Branch COG received one stone bid for Plunketts Creek Township. The bid was from Glenn O Hawbaker: 2A subbase \$7.00 FOB, \$11.25 delivered, no bid for tailgated; 2RC subbase \$6.50 FOB, \$11.50 delivered, no bid for tailgated; R-8 Rock \$20.00 FOB, \$29.00 delivered. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to accept Glenn O Hawbaker's bid. We will be checking state piggyback prices from other stone companies to determine if they may be cheaper.

Ray wants to have Municipal Services come and re-evaluate the Turkey Farm Road project estimate.

Roads will be swept and graded as soon as the weather cooperates.

Gary Springman is going to sand blast the box for the F350 and Gary Abernatha is going to paint it. Ray is getting prices for a trailer to mount the leaf blower to – Tractor Supply has a frame trailer with a hitch and lights for \$300. Ray will be getting prices for a new three point hitch flail mower. A curb brush is needed for the street sweeper.

Ray Murphy is to call Valley Ag and Turf to come and service the John Deere tractor.

Bob Kaiser sent a letter to Richard Straley (Best Beach) informing him that Foresman's report shows his two septic systems are in satisfactory working condition. Richard Straley has already contacted John Lavelle at County asking for his occupancy permit. John will be drafting a letter stating that since his septic system passed inspected he can now apply for his annual campground zoning permit (required for all campgrounds located in a flood zone).
