

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday August 4, 2008 at 7 PM in the Township Building.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved with the addition of "no bids for stone were received".

GUESTS: Lonnie and Connie Snell came again to request that the Supervisors consider a nuisance animal ordinance. The Snell's frustration is understood but the Supervisors again stated that they will not consider any kind of nuisance ordinance due to the difficulty of enforcing these types of ordinances. It is frustrating that the SPCA is not asserting their authority but trying to push the responsibility onto the local municipalities who are not equipped with the proper staff to address these situations.

There were no stone bids to open at 7:15 PM.

One Seal Coat Bid was received from HRI Inc. with a total bid price of \$25,595.75. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to reject this bid, cancel the tar and chip project on Barbour's Cemetery Road and Cabbage Hollow Rd and change the project for this year's county aid.

REPORTS: Planning Commission: The Act 537 Plan update to address small stream discharge system inspections was reviewed at their meeting and approval was recommended by unanimous vote. A request was made to the Supervisors for timely notification of personnel changes when they affect the Planning Commission.

The Robert and Susan Emick single-lot subdivision was recommended for approval by unanimous vote with the following stipulations: 1. This lot is not guaranteed to be a building lot. 2. A Highway Occupancy Permit must be obtained from the PA Department of Transportation (PADOT) prior to the initiation of driveway construction. 3. A roadway use and maintenance agreement between the Emick's and the Brown's must be recorded with this plan.

Recreation: The Penn State Cooperative Extension Office was contacted regarding the honey bees. Ken Dangle, a local beekeeper, called back and said that the bees could be rescued but only by cutting down the tree. If left alone the bees would not be around this winter so the tree could be cut down at that time so there is no honey comb left to draw future bees to

that tree. Bruce Frymire will be contacted to determine if he still wants the bees. The ping pong table was stolen from the pavilion, it was placed out there so it could be used during summer rec since there was not enough space for it in room #2. Summer Rec is going well.
