

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order Monday, December 7, 2009 at 7:05 PM in the Township Building.

GUESTS: Larry Emery came to ask about the camper at Hidden Valley that should have been removed after the 1996 flood and was not. A map was printed and will be forwarded to Allen Bennett so he can address the situation to make sure no campers are left in the floodplain.

REPORTS: PCTVFD: No Report.

Planning Commission: Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to re-appoint Britt Bassett to the planning commission with a term ending 1/31/2014. The Haight subdivision was unanimously recommended for approval by the planning commission. Note: Item #1 on the Lycoming County review letter is incorrect. Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to approve the Haight add on lot subdivision with no stipulations.

Recreation Commission: No Report.

Zoning Officer: No Report. An email update was read.

Emergency Management: No Report. Barricades are on their way and a pager needs replaced.

Roadmaster: The spreaders are on the trucks. The radio from the F800 will be put in the F350 and the broken radio from the F350 will be repaired. The roller has been leveled up. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote to purchase a 180,000 BTU furnace with power vent at a price of around \$4,000 for the old equipment building.

CONTINUING BUSINESS: If no check is received from Robin Real Estate by Wednesday 12/9/09 Brett Feese will be instructed to sue.

PennDOT granted approval to install hidden driveway signs at Woolever Lane along Route 87 At Little Bear Creek Rd. Ray needs to meet with the Raytek's to locate where the no parking signs needs reinstalled.

NEW BUSINESS: Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to approve the proposed 2010 budget for advertisement and inspection.

Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to hire Design Systems Technologies Inc. as the Township Sewage Enforcement Officer.

The bank stabilization project on Turkey Farm Rd seems to only be a 3 foot depth instead of the contracted 6 foot depth according to Barry Garverick from PennDOT Municipal Services. The Supervisors would like to meet with Brent and Curt from Gutelius Excavating to determine what depth the rock was laid and why it took only half the amount of estimated rock.

Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to have Gary sign the 2 year Memorandum of Understanding between Lycoming County and Plunketts Creek Township for Zoning Officer services.
