The Regular Meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Supervisors was adjourned at 7:12 PM

A Public Hearing to receive comments and recommendations of interested individuals residing within the township concerning Project 87, LLC and or its assignee Pier 87's intent to acquire an economic development license from the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board was called to order at 7:12 PM. There was only one comment from a resident who prefers to remain anonymous. They asked that it be known the owners of Project 87, LLC were part of the bid process for the liquor license sold by the Caseman's and Project 87, LLC made the decision to drop out and therefore did not win the bid.

The Regular Meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Supervisors was re-convened at 7:20 PM. Ray Lewis made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to sign the resolution stating that the issuance of an Economic Development Liquor License, to Project Route 87, LLC and or its assignee, Pier 87, LLC, would not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of Plunketts Creek Township or its residents, is hereby approved.

Recreation Commission: Christmas Party December 18th at 2 PM at the PCTVFD. All mulch has been spread on playground until Spring.

PCTVFD: Brad Simpson came on behalf of the fire department to ask whether the requested fire tax increase was approved at the budget meeting. The Supervisors explained that they feel the Fire Department should not get more money than the Township and the Fire Department already gets half of the total real estate taxes levied by the Township and the Supervisors do not want to increase taxes therefore there was no increase granted.

The Supervisors would like to remind the Fire Department that under the current board no request for specific funding has ever been denied.

Brad also asked the Supervisors to work with Verizon if a request for phone service is ever turned in for the cabins on Little Bear Creek Rd. The recent cabin fire was fully engulfed because the property owner had to drive 2 miles to use a phone to call 911.

Emergency Management: We dodged another bullet on December 1st. The Loyalsock Creek height was 14' 8". Some of Scaife Rd was under but no other roads.

Roadmaster: A big tree fell on Dunwoody Rd and the root ball that is still there needs removed. Dave Stryker will be removing it and hauling it away. Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to order an 8' stainless steel slide in cinder spreader for the F350 from Bastian's for a Costars total price of \$3995 installed. The welders will be coming soon to finish the work on the trucks.

Zoning Officer: There will be a Zoning Hearing Board hearing on Wednesday, December 8th for Acker – Shed – Lower Barbour's Rd between Pierce and Blair.

CONTINUING BUSINESS: Gary will call Dan Vasallo about the Lower Manor Rd project.

Kathy Hunter will get back to us before the January 3 meeting about the Stormwater Ordinance.

NEW BUSINESS: Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to approve the proposed 2011 budget for advertisement and inspection

We will bid our stone in February.
