REPORTS: PCTVFD: No Report

Planning Commission: Will be having a meeting this month.

Recreation Commission: Christmas Party will be December 17th at 3 PM at the PCTVFD. There is a possible mold issue in the Library closet, the outside door by the basement door and in the basement. I will call ServePro to come look around the building and give us an estimate on whatever needs done.

Sewage Officer: Ron Tenerovich – Hoppestown Rd – Technical Assistance
Pier 87 – Route 87 – 2 probes & 2 test pits

Emergency Management: Allen Kaplan is gathering data from this storm and past storms and looking into the cost of an automatic calling system. Sullivan County REC may be willing to help us out with this. Still working on a radio tower with Cascade. They have talked about adding more sirens down Route 87. Also, looking at other types of disasters like those from the gas industry.

Roadmaster: The backside of Dunwoody Rd has been repaired so it can be plowed this winter. Last week the fill given by Gutelius was hauled and spread on the cove section of Manor Rd to get it plowable for winter. All of the roads except Dunwoody Rd are plowable for winter. Ray put up the road closed signs at both ends of Dunwoody Rd and gave Dunwoody Club the saw horse barricade to stop people from driving past the club and getting stuck. The Grouse Club wants to put up a gate for liability reasons. Ray graded and rolled the Grouse Club's road but it needs graded again as they dumped more stone. Jean Fetterman thanks us for fixing her road.
