

The end of year meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order Thursday, December 30, 2010 at 7:00 PM in the Township Building.

CONTINUING BUSINESS: The slide-in cinder spreader approved at the December 6th Township meeting was never ordered by Bastian's so Ray would like to reconsider this purchase. It was brought to his attention that once a slide in spreader is installed the truck can no longer be used as a dump truck until the spreader is removed. This would make extra work for our employees if potholes needed filled before the last snowfall in spring if both of the dump trucks had slide in spreaders. Ray will get a price from Bradco on a new tailgate spreader for the F350 so it could still be used to haul stone while the spreader is still attached.

NEW BUSINESS: Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to keep the real estate tax rates for 2011 the same at .641 mill municipal tax and .641 mill fire tax.

Marvin, made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to adopt the 2011 budget as prepared.

Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to sell the jointly owned leaf blower back to Cascade Township for 1/2 of the fair market value. Ray will get an estimate of the fair market value from Bradco.
