Barbours Cemetery Road:

Road is in good shape. The turnaround has debris and cement mixer stored for the cabin being constructed. Letter may need to be sent for clearing the turnaround as resident was warned in spring.

Turkey Farm Road:

Road is in good shape and needs the brush cleaned out.

Scaife Road:

Road needs to be tarred/chipped. Trees need trimming

Cabbage Hollow Road:

Needs some ditch work but road is in good condition. Roadmaster Brad Stine believes there are still two pipes that need replaced.

Hickory Lane:

This road is in good shape

Lower Manor Road/Upper Manor- Loyalsock Manor:

Road is in need of being tarred/chipped. Trees need trimming

Dunwoody Road:

The road could use recon on lower end but the length is too small to do it cost effectively. Wait until there is other recon work to be done. The ditch has areas that should have #4's put in due to the depth of the ditch and softness of the dirt. Ditches also need cleaned out and more road reflectors should be installed along the creek area.

During the road tour a property on lower manor road was found to have a garage falling down which should have letter sent for clean-up per the property maintenance ordinance.

The road tour was ended at 11:00 a.m.
