

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order Monday, July 6, 2009 at 7:05 PM in the Township Building.

GUESTS: Jeff Kyle came to discuss the 2009 – 2010 insurance policies. Due to one larger than normal work comp policy there was a 25% increase in the experience mod which equated to a 20% increase in the work comp policy. The price for the 2009-2010 package is \$17,187 an increase of \$1287.
