

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, July 12, 2010 at 7:15 PM in the Township Building.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved with adjustments

GUESTS: Jeff Kyle came to discuss the 2010 – 2011 insurance policies. Due to one larger than normal work comp claim there was a 19% increase in the experience mod which equated to an 18% increase in the work comp policy. The price for the 2010 – 2011 package is \$7,993 and Work Comp \$10,747 which totals \$18,740 an increase of \$1459 over last year. While Jeff was here the Supervisors made value changes to the contractor equipment, removed some scheduled property (mostly old EMA stuff) and added comp to the Dodge and the Army truck and removed collision from the street sweeper.

REPORTS: Playground Equipment Committee: Annie updated the Supervisors on where the committee stands. There is a sale currently running that would potentially allow us to have the playground installed for just a nominal fee above the purchase cost. Ray feels that it is in the best interest of the Township for the Supervisors to donate the site prep in addition to the \$10,000 already agreed to. The Hall's did not come to the meeting and when contacted they said there is no guarantee that they can remove the old equipment the day the Supervisors want them to as Dennis is back to work and may not be available. Annie will contact the Playground Company to get final prices and information for the next Township Meeting.
