

The regular meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order Monday, March 2, 2009 at 7:10 PM in the Township Building.

REPORTS: PCTVFD: The Supervisors were shown an example of the new billing system the Fire Department is implementing. It is similar to the Ambulance Service billing.

Jeremy Welshans would like to join Task Force 80, a county wide specially trained response team. The fire company was unsure if he would be covered under workers comp. The Supervisors like that he is interested in being trained for such a position. DGK will be contacted about coverage. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to approve the request for Jeremy Welshans to join task force 80 and begin his training provided he has work comp coverage.

There are 12 firemen going to MAMA for fire school training in Mid-March.

Planning Commission: A letter was received from Hess & Hess with the executed copy of the Snyder subdivision approval letter. Mr. Hess will have executed copies of the water and road agreements between the Snyder's and the Kreider's to the township before the April 6th meeting.

Recreation Commission: No Report

Sewage Officer: Brooke Mann & Matt Sehenuk – Mountain Rd – Issued Elevated Sand Mound.

Per Bob Kiaser at Lycoming Sanitary Allan Straley has come to him and could not find anyone to inspect his septic system. Bob told him to try again because he will not get his seasonal campground permit until his system is inspected.

Emergency Management: Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to appoint Allen Kaplan as PCT EMA Coordinator. The deputies have agreed to continue in their positions and work with Allen. They have their equipment back. A PA State Police background check needs done. The results must be sent along with Allen's application to County EMA - they will forward it to PEMA for his official appointment.

Roadmaster: There is a pipe on Turkey Farm Rd that needs replaced, the concrete has separated. Mark Murawski from Lycoming County said that the money from 2004 is still escrowed for the Turkey Farm Road project. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to re-start the Turkey farm Rd project and complete it.

Zoning Officer: No Report.

NEW BUSINESS: Gary requested that flyers be posted on the Township and Brennan's Bear Necessities (The Proctor Store) bulletin boards about Clean Up Day. He also requested that the meeting dates list be posted on the Township bulletin board.

Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to give the PCT Playground Committee approval to submit a DCNR C2P2 grant application in the name of Plunketts Creek Township.

The Supervisors request that the Playground committee try to get other estimates, in addition to Larson Design Group, for the sketch plan. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to use the funds donated by individuals and businesses to pay for a sketch plan of the proposed playground project not to exceed \$1000.

Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to bid 37 tons bulk rock salt through the costars piggyback program for 2009-2010.

The West Branch COG training show will be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2009. Marvin and Gary will be going.

All of the Supervisors will be going to the West Branch COG meeting on March 17th to hear the presentation by Renee' Carey in regards to the development of a Rivers Conservation Plan for the Loyalsock Creek Watershed by the Northcentral Pennsylvania Conservancy.
