

The regular meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order Monday March 4, 2013 at 7:00 PM in the township building.

Supervisor Marvin Springman made a motion with unanimous approval for February meeting minutes to be approved.

The Plunketts Creek Auditors requested an extension on the yearly audit as they will not be able to meet their March 10<sup>th</sup> deadline. Supervisor Ray Lewis made a motion with unanimous approval to approve the auditor's extension.

Britt Bassett requested that the Township re-evaluate their Engineer with consideration given to Bassett Engineering for the Township Engineer. Supervisor Gary Abernatha explained that with the FEMA/PEMA project worksheet problems and Dunwoody Road that he feels it would be prudent for the Township to remain with the current Engineer Tim Wentz since he has worked with the government entities from the beginning. But when all is settled the Supervisors will re-evaluate and take into consideration Britt's request. Britt will forward to the Secretary a fee schedule for comparison.

Fire Company would like to use buyout housing from FEMA/PEMA and also would like permission to have tractor pulls. Supervisor Marvin Springman made a motion with unanimous approval for the Fire Company to have the tractor pulls again in the same location as last year and to allow the Fire Company to use the buyout housing for training purposes over the March 17<sup>th</sup> weekend. The PCTVFD also presented their 2012 and 2013 budgets and a copy of the billing ordinance from another Township for review.

Jim Lewis would like permission to purchase fire cones for the Fire Police at a cost of \$250.00 each. Supervisor Gary Abernatha made a motion with unanimous approval for the Fire Police to purchase eight cones and present the bill to the Township for payment.
