Planning Commission: Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to re-approve the Snyder / Kreider sub-division with the following stipulations: 1) a signed right-of-way use and maintenance agreement between Merrill and Charlotte Snyder and Frederick and Barbara Kreider must be recorded with this plan, 2) a signed water use agreement between Merrill and Charlotte Snyder and Frederick and Barbara Kreider must be recorded with this plan.
