REPORTS: PCTVFD: The bucket truck agreement was given to the Supervisors for their review. An agreement for a non-profit rental of the truck is still being drawn up. Once they are both done and reviewed by the Supervisors then the decision to sign or not sign the fire company / Township agreement will be made.

Roadmaster: The slide on Dunwoody Rd has been repaired. Ray would like to get matting with grass seed, from Fry's Plastic, to cover the exposed bank. We received a quote from Stephenson Equipment on a JCB Skid Steer at a price of \$48,916.04. This quote does not include a grader blade. ABH Equipment is to be getting us a quote on a truck. The Convention was the same old same old. Ray ordered cutting edges and the chain for the slide in cinder spreader from Bastians. The John Deere tractor and the transmission need serviced so Ray Murphy will call Deerefield Ag and Turf to set it up.

Sewage Officer: Bill Toth brought us up to speed on what projects remain open and where he stands on those projects. He has agreed to send a written monthly report to the Township. He will look into the Wright's malfunctioning system to see where they are in the project timeline.

A letter needs sent to Cascade agreeing to sell the jointly owned Leaf Blower to them for a price of \$450. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to purchase a new Giant Leaf Vac Blower from Bradco Supply for \$3995.00

NEW BUSINESS: All Supervisors are in agreement to accept the bid from Hammaker, bid through the West branch COG, at a price of \$37184.40 for Double Coat of Turkey Farm Rd and the backside of Dunwoody Rd and \$8225.64 for an additional prime coat on Turkey Farm Rd.

Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to apply the 2011 County Aid in the amount of \$2776.00 to the tar and chip project on the backside of Dunwoody Rd.

Marvin is going to the West branch COG show.

The Supervisors are all in agreement to have Spako chip the limbs from the Spruce trees after they cut them down for a price of about \$400 to \$500.

The Supervisors then went into an executive session.
