

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, November 1, 2010 at 7 PM in the Township Building.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read.

GUESTS: Brad Russell and Frank Morrone came to ask the Supervisors to consider passing a resolution in support of Pier 87 obtaining an economic development liquor license. Brad and Frank agreed to cover all costs incurred by the Township in considering this Resolution. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to hold a public hearing during the regularly scheduled Supervisor meeting of December 6, 2010.

REPORTS: Playground Equipment Committee: The day after the last meeting the Playground installation company called and began work immediately. Garth and Susan Everett, Cub Scouts from Pack 88, members of the Playground Equipment Committee and even some local children all came to help mulch the playground on October 16<sup>th</sup>. One more load of mulch needs spread and then we are done until Spring.

Sewage Office: No Report – Allen Kaplan got his soil report but the Township has no copy as of yet. Allen believes we should compile a list of septic system designers to hand out to potential applicants.

Planning Commission: Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to appoint Joel Wessner to replace Dave Ulmer with a term ending 1/31/2015

Recreation Commission: Halloween went well thanks to Ray for the hayride. The Christmas Party will be December 18<sup>th</sup> at 2 PM at the PCTVFD firehall.

PCTVFD: Brad took care of determining which ALS responders will be called in what order when an emergency arises.

Emergency Management: Siren testing will begin again on the first Monday of every month (once the Newsletter goes out) and it will be sounded for any widespread emergency. The Verizon hot spot and wi-fi are up and working at the firehall.

Keith Hinkal will give Amanda a laminated map of the campground to be kept in the ambulance in the event if an emergency.

Roadmaster: The F350 has a new bottom in the dump box, some wiring needs redone and the plow frame in the front will be plated. New fenders and a plate for the rotating light were made for the F450. The well pump needs wired up and the furnace needs installed in the maintenance building. Pipe for the downspouts at the office building was picked up.

Dave Stryker delivered and placed stone, that is not state approved, on the tar and chip sections by the Dunwoody Club that have disintegrated. The stone is to be paid for out of the General Fund as a test project.

Ray would like to purchase a skid steer instead of replacing the backhoe. He will get prices.

The auger on the F350 tailgate spreader needs replaced. Ray will get a price for a slide-in spread instead.
