Supervisor Marvin Springman made a motion with unanimous approval for the October meeting minutes to be approved as written as well as the budget meeting minutes.

Tim Wentz, Plunketts Creek Township Engineer gave update on the Dunwoody Road project presenting Plunketts Creek Supervisors with a book containing all the permits which will be sent to DEP to review the complete package which has a timeline of 60-90 days. Currently negotiations are ongoing with the property owners for easements which are being handled by the Township Solicitor.

Jeff Brooks ask to speak to the Supervisors at this meeting concerning a sewage module for a stream discharge system on a Wallis Run Road property. Jeff will be submitting the plan to the Plunketts Creek Township Planning Commission for review after he receives approval from DEP. Jeff provided the Township with a sample of an installation and maintenance agreement which will set forth a specific amount of money in a shared escrow from the property owner when the plans are submitted and go forth. Supervisor Gary Abernatha discussed another such system which has caused some problems in the Township – Jeff left print of the system for Supervisors to peruse in case they have any questions.
