

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, October 6, 2008 at 7:00 PM in the Township Building.

GUESTS: Jim Etzel came to ask the Supervisors to approve the formation of a committee to do supplemental purchasing for the Barbours Link. At this time Jim Etzel and Donna McCarty, a third person to be named later, would like to form a three member board endorsed by the Supervisors, similar to the Recreation Board. The James V Brown Library made a request to the PCT Foundation for a general fund donation which was denied. But, the PCT Foundation would consider a request for funding from a group that would make purchases and donate them to the Link. Ray made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to have Jim Etzel write up by-laws to form the Barbours Link purchasing group.

Maggie Emery came to request that the Township write a thank you letter to PennDOT to show appreciation for the new bridge and run around during construction. The Supervisors were all in agreement to write that letter.

Lonnie and Connie Snell came to discuss their request for a Nuisance Dog/Animal Ordinance. Lonnie talked to Joe Walker who is a constable in Lycoming County and he said that he could work independently for a Township. According to Lonnie, Joe could enforce an ordinance for fines plus cost therefore it would not cost the Township much to enforce such an ordinance. The Supervisors agreed to look into this possibility.

REPORTS: Planning Commission: No Report

Recreation: The Tot Time families are going to Styer's for a hayride and to pick a pumpkin from the patch, tomorrow, October 7<sup>th</sup>. The annual Halloween party, spook walk and hayride will be held Saturday, October 25<sup>th</sup> at 6 PM. The rain date is Sunday, October 26<sup>th</sup>. Hopefully Ehrlich has de-fleaed the rec room.

Zoning Officer: A letter was received from Marc Drier, attorney for Allen Straley, saying that he feels Allen should not have to test his septic system since he has been using the campground since he purchased it. The letter was forwarded to Brett along with supporting documentation from our file. Brett sent a response but the Township has not received a copy yet.

PCTVFD: The annual haunted hayride is being held October 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> and the 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> at the Consolidated Sportsman grounds.

Emergency Management: Gary will sign the NIMS compliance matrix letter for County EMA.

Roadmaster: The front tires on the grader have been replaced. Cabbage Hollow Rd and Scaife Rd have been graded. Stryker will haul stone for us. Hanson will sell us our stone at the same price as if they had been awarded the bid. They did not see the ad or they would have bid our stone. Salt has been ordered. Per Susquehanna Supply, PennDOT has decided to add burms on the dead end section of Lower Manor Road that goes back to Bonnie Mosteller's. Once the burms are done Ray wants all three Supervisors to look at the road before any paperwork is signed. Once everyone agrees that the job is complete then a letter needs to be sent from the Township stating such.

The road crew is trying to finish sealing up the maintenance building. Ray feels that the Supervisors need to discuss pounding a well. The pressure washer needs fixed again.

CONTINUING BUSINESS: The Township needs to get an estimate on removing architectural barriers to handicap individuals to apply for a CDBG grant. Rachelle Ricotta, LCPC, and Bill Lowthert, SEDA-COG both feel we have a good project for funding but it will not cover all expenses to bring the building up to ADA compliance.

NEW BUSINESS: Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to pass resolution #2008-2 to adopt the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Planning Study and Update to Add Small Sewage Treatment Facilities.

The Supervisors authorize Ray Murphy to mow Mary Jane Schreck's and Ed Rightmire's driveways at a cost of \$45 per hour with operator.
