

The regular monthly meeting of the Plunketts Creek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on Monday, October 4, 2010 at 7 PM in the Township Building.

He will take down the Plaque restore it and put it back up for a fee of approximately \$300. Marvin made a motion, with unanimous affirmative vote, to have Harold restore the sign for \$300.

REPORTS: Playground Equipment Committee: Volunteers are lined up to spread mulch as soon as the equipment is installed (probably the last week of October). Ray expressed his appreciation to Annie and all of the volunteers that helped him with the removal of the old equipment and the site prep.

Ray will bring his personal tractor and chauffeur the hayrides because he does not want the Township tractors being used because of all the attachments on them.
