

Plunketts Creek Township
Spring Road Tour
April 4, 2015

The semi-annual spring road tour of the Plunketts Creek Township Supervisors was held on Saturday, April 4, 2015, and started at Township building at 8:00 a.m.

Stone Bid was opened from Hanson Aggregates and will be presented to all the Board at the Monday night meeting held April 6, 2015 as there was not a quorum available for vote.

Barbours Cemetery Road:

Road is in good shape the ditches need cleaned and road needs swept. The turnaround has debris stored for the cabin being constructed – Supervisor Ray Lewis stopped the brother of the family and advised they needed to move the construction equipment back so the turnaround is clear.

Turkey Farm Road:

Road is in good shape except for the large culvert at the end of the road needs cleaned out. The road sign needs attention.

Scaife Road:

Road needs to be saw cut and blacktop as well as stoned near the narrow road sign. There are places the road needs to have stone plus the potholes need to be filled in. A few of the pipes need cleaned out.

Cabbage Hollow Road:

The first pipe needs replaced. The stumps need to go and reflector posts need replaced where they are missing. Ditches need cleaned and road should be raked and rolled with a load of stone on it. Also need to check the pipe at end which may still be steel pipe- should be replaced with plastic.

Hickory Lane:

This road is in good shape

Lower Manor Road/Upper Manor- Loyalsock Manor:

Put a box over end of the first pipe as the pipe itself is in good shape. Road is in need of being tarred/chipped.

Dunwoody Road:

The road has stumps that need to be removed including the one that claimed the snow plow – two pipes need replaced and should be done prior to Verizon burying their cable. Road needs to have gravel in parts of the last section and ditches need cleaned in areas of the road. Lower end of road has three pipes that need replaced the upper end has one pipe that needs replaced.

As no quorum was present the tour was ended at 11:00 a.m.
