- Mr. Mann – 478-2598 complaints on Cemetery Road – about 100’ up road tree hanging over the road on edges. On the steep hill where pipe went in road sinking can be filled in. Above Mr. Mann’s house a tree is sticking out over the road far enough to scratch cars. At the cemetery entrance – the way to turn down the road is fixed but to turn up the road there is a hole where the culvert pipe is – can a grate be put on that so those turning up do not fall into the culvert. Also – Scaife Road sign is missing – new one needs ordered.
- Lycoming County Liquid Fuels Grant program—Secretary will look into replacement signs cost so maybe this grant can be applied for – but application need accepted by September 4th.
